Acts 14:1-28

1. Who are the they of verse 1?
2. Where did they go?
3. What did they do there? What was the response?
4. Where are Lycaonia, Lystra, Derbe?
5. What happens in Lystra? What is the response of the people?
6. How do Paul and Barnabus respond?
7. What happens to Paul? Where are the Jews who stone him from?
8. How do Paul and Barnabus encourage the disciples?

Interpretation: What does this passage mean?

Acts 14:1-28

1. What would you say is the theme of this passage?
2. Why do the Jews oppose the message of Paul? Why do they stone him?
3. Why do these people treat Paul and Barnabus like gods?
4. Compare verse 21 with Matthew 28:19-20.
5. Was Paul dead? Is there a miracle being described in verse 20?
6. What does this passage teach us about church leadership (v.23)?
7. Map out this beginning of Paul's Missionary journey.
