Observation Questions, "What does the passage say?"

Acts 22:1-30

1. Make observations from this passage using the 5 questions: Who, what, why, where, when, how???
2. How does Paul address the crowd he is speaking to?
3. How does he describe himself? What does he admit to doing?
4. How does he describe his conversion experience?
5. What does the Lord tell Paul in the temple (vs. 17-21)?
6. What is the response to Paul's sermon (vs. 22ff.)?
7. What does Paul say to the centurion as he is about to beat him?
8. What happens as Paul shares the fact that he is a Roman citizen?
9. What is the ultimate result (v. 30)?

Interpretation: What does this passage mean?

Acts 22:1-30

1. Compare Paul's background information here with Philippians 3. What do we know about Paul?
2. Compare Paul's testimony here with the description of the event in Acts 9. Note any similarities and differences.
3. Why do the Jews respond to Paul the way they do? What in his sermon was so offensive?
4. What difference does being a Roman citizen make? Why does Paul appeal to his citizenship here but not before?

Application: What does the passage mean to me?
